Grassroots Advocates March to U.S. Capitol to protest Illegal Horse Meat Found Contaminating the U.S. Food Supply and Call for Passage of Bill to Ban U.S. Horse Slaughter

#### SAFE FOOD SAFE HORSES

- Last year over 160,000 US horses were sent to slaughter for human consumption in Europe and Asia.
- We do not raise horses in this country for food under food safety guide lines and we medicate them differently than food animals. Giving them substances banned from any animal intended for food. Banned because they can kill humans and or cause life long problems
- Your TÁX dollars will pay for the inspection of horse meat.
- Sending contaminated meat into the food supply is an act of **Bio-terrorism**
- A recent study found horse meat in ground meat products here in the USA. <u>ACT NOW</u> to protect our food supply.
- Horse slaughter plants are COMMUNITY KILLERS!

We cannot afford to introduce a non-food animal into the food supply in this country. Food Safety needs to be a top priority, do not put our families at risk .





92% of the horses going to slaughter are young, sound, healthy horses.

Every day horses are sent to slaughter, foals 6 months and older go to slaughter, while the others are pulled from their mothers and discarded to starve and die.

WHAT CAN YOU DO? Contact your Congressmen & Senators at 202-224-3121 and ask them to support S.1214 & H.R. 1942, the S.A.F.E. Act (Safeguarding American Food Exports) to end the slaughter & transport of US horses for food. Citizens Against Equine Slaughter is a registered 501c3 non -profit.
