On the Cover Spotlight



Galamaya+ continued her winning ways in the Sport Horse disciplines in 2014. Galamaya+ is a 16.2 hand Arabian/Hanoverian mare, by the Arabian stallion, Journeey, out of Gabriela. With trainer Ryan Yap, she competed successfully in Open and Class "A" Arabian Dressage competitions. Maya earned her Legion of Honor in the summer of 2014, accumulating points in the Half-Arabian Sport Horse In-Hand division (Open and Amateur) and in Training, First and Second Level Dressage. 90% of her scores have been earned in Open competition. Highlights of the show season included a Reserve Championship at the Region X Show in HA/AA Sport Horse Mares In-Hand, Amateur to Handle and a Top 5 in HA/AA Sport Horse Mares, Open. Maya concluded the show season with an excellent showing at the KDA/USDF Region 2 Dressage Show at the Kentucky Horse Park. Region 2 was the largest dressage regional show in the country, with 700+ horses – she was one of only three Arabians/Half-Arabians to compete. (Cover photo shows her in the Rolex Arena at the Kentucky Horse Park.)Maya's placings earned her the 2014 Champion USEF Region X Horse of the Year in the Half-Arabian division at Training Level and a 6th place in the USEF Region X Horse of the Year program in Half-Arabian Sport Horse In-Hand.

Design Tips to Beat The Summer Heat

When building a barn it's important to consider your climate and how the change of seasons can affect your horses. Incorporating design elements to increase comfort during the summer months is a smart and cost-effective strategy that will make a substantial difference in the comfort level inside the barn.

As experienced equestrian barn builders, B&D Builders recommends the following design tips to help you and your horses beat the heat.

Dormer Windows – Dormer windows add character to your custom barn design and are an effective way to increase air circulation in the summer months.

Front & Rear Doors – A dual door design provides great cross-ventilation as well as the flexibility to always have one door open as the sun moves from east to west. From Sliding to Dutch – doors add design and functionality.

High Roof – Because warm air rises, designing your barn with a high roof keeps the heat well above the stalls and main work areas.

Cupola & Exhaust Fan – Adding a cupola and fan system is an effective method of pulling hot air up and out, while bringing in cooler air. To be effective, it's important the cupola is the appropriate size for the barn being built.

Covered Porches – Adding a roof to your porch not only looks inviting, it also cools the air closest to your barn. This added shelter is also a great place to groom your horse before
